If you look at the answers so you can do well on the test, you are of low integrity.

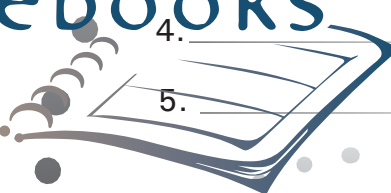
- What does your answer say about your character?
